- Discover how Harriet Tubman and the slave, Tilly, escaped
- Learn about a Civil War Southern sympathizer living in a border state
- Compare fibers and view weaving on looms over 100 years old.
- Discover the economic importance of Governor Ross's efforts to bring the railroad to the area
- Observe how people dressed and contributed to life on the plantation.
- Participate in hands-on activities
- Opportunity to purchase Victorian toys, books, ornaments, etc. at the gift shop; priced from \$0.25 to \$20.00.

Tours can be modified to meet academic needs at various grade levels.

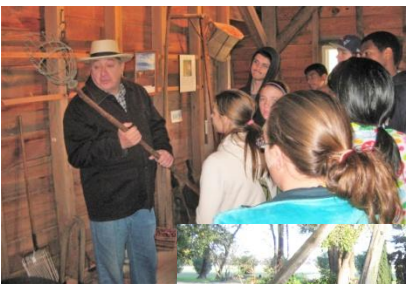
Picnic area is available for lunch.
